

## Pletal® (cilostazol) - New warning

- On May 17, 2017 the FDA approved an update to the *Warnings and Precautions* section of the Pletal (cilostazol) drug label regarding left ventricular outflow tract obstruction.
- Pletal is indicated for the reduction of symptoms of intermittent claudication, as demonstrated by an increased walking distance.
- Left ventricular outflow tract obstruction has been reported in patients with sigmoid shaped interventricular septum.
- Patients should be monitored for the development of a new systolic murmur or cardiac symptoms after starting Pletal.
- Pletal carries a boxed warning stating that it is contraindicated in heart failure patients.



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
