- On December 22, 2021, [Teva launched](#) an [AB-rated](#) generic version of Emergent BioSolutions' [Narcan \(naloxone\)](#) 4 mg nasal spray.
 - In addition, [Sandoz launched](#) an authorized brand alternative of Narcan 4 mg nasal spray.
- Narcan is approved for the emergency treatment of known or suspected opioid overdose, as manifested by respiratory and/or central nervous system depression.
- Naloxone for the treatment of opioid overdose is also available as a brand 8 mg nasal spray ([Kloxxado®](#)) and generically as an [injection](#).
