

Proventil[®] HFA (albuterol) – First-time generic (authorized generic)

- On April 5, 2019, Endo announced that one of its operating companies, Par, launched an authorized generic version of Merck's Proventil HFA (albuterol) inhalation aerosol.
- Proventil HFA is indicated in adults and children 4 years of age and older for the treatment or
 prevention of bronchospasm with reversible obstructive airway disease and for the prevention of
 exercise-induced bronchospasm.
- Albuterol is also available generically as oral <u>tablets</u>, oral <u>extended-release tablets</u>, oral <u>syrup</u>, inhalation nebulizer <u>solution</u>, and combination <u>ipratropium/albuterol</u> inhalation solution; and as an authorized generic inhalation <u>aerosol</u>; and as a branded inhalation powder (<u>ProAir Respiclick</u>[®]).
 - Albuterol tablets and extended-release tablets are approved for the relief of bronchospasm in adults and children 6 years of age and older with reversible obstructive airway disease.
 - Albuterol syrup is approved for the relief of bronchospasm in adults and children 2 years of age and older with reversible obstructive airway disease.
 - Albuterol nebulizer solution is approved for the relief of bronchospasm in patients 2 years of age and older with reversible obstructive airway disease and acute attacks of bronchospasm.
 - Ipratropium/albuterol is approved for the treatment of bronchospasm associated with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease in patients requiring more than one bronchodilator.
 - Albuterol inhalation aerosol and ProAir Respiclick carry the same indications as Proventil HFA.



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
