



## Advair Diskus<sup>®</sup> (fluticasone propionate/salmeterol) – First-time generic launch update

- On February 12, 2019, [Mylan launched Wixela<sup>™</sup> Inhub<sup>™</sup>](#), an [AB-rated](#) generic version of GlaxoSmithKline's [Advair Diskus \(fluticasone propionate/salmeterol\)](#) inhalation powder.
  - In addition, on February 8, 2019, [Prasco launched](#) an authorized generic version of Advair Diskus.
- Advair Diskus is approved for the twice-daily treatment of asthma in patients aged 4 years and older, and for the twice-daily maintenance treatment of airflow obstruction in patients with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, including chronic bronchitis and/or emphysema.



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
