- On October 26, 2016, generic versions of Daiichi Sankyo's <u>Azor (amlodipine/olmesartan)</u> and <u>Tribenzor</u> (olmesartan/amlodipine/hydrochlorothiazide) tablets were launched.
 - Teva launched an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Azor.
 - Par launched an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Tribenzor.
 - Sun Pharmaceuticals also launched authorized generics of Azor and Tribenzor.
 - Torrent's launch plans for an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Tribenzor are pending.
 - Macleods' launch plans for an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Azor are pending.
- Azor and Tribenzor are indicated for the treatment of hypertension, to lower blood pressure. Azor may be used alone or with other agents.
