



Chantix® (varenicline) – First-time generic

- On September 22, 2021, [Endo announced](#) the launch of an [AB-rated](#) generic version of Pfizer's [Chantix \(varenicline\)](#) 0.5 mg and 1 mg tablets.
- Chantix is approved for use as an aid to smoking cessation treatment.
- According to IQVIA, Chantix tablet sales were approximately \$1 billion for the 12 months ending on June 30, 2021.
- On September 16, 2021, [Pfizer announced](#) a voluntary consumer-level recall of all lots of brand Chantix tablets.
