

## Glucagon® Emergency Kit for Low Blood Sugar (glucagon) – First-time generic

- On December 29, 2020, <u>Amphastar announced</u> the <u>FDA approval</u> of an <u>AP-rated</u> generic version of Eli Lilly's <u>Glucagon Emergency Kit for Low Blood Sugar (glucagon)</u>.
  - Amphastar plans to launch its generic glucagon within two months.
- Glucagon is approved as a treatment for severe hypoglycemia which may occur in patients with
  diabetes mellitus and as a diagnostic aid in the radiologic examination of the stomach, duodenum,
  small bowel, and colon when diminished intestinal motility would be advantageous.
- Glucagon is also available as a brand injection by Fresenius Kabi that carries similar indications.
- According to IQVIA, the U.S. sales for Eli Lilly's Glucagon Emergency Kit for Low Blood Sugar were approximately \$144 million, for the 12 months ended September 30, 2020.



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
