



Istalol[®] (timolol maleate) – First-time generic

- On November 27, 2017, [Apotex announced](#) the launch of an [AT rated](#) generic version of Bausch and Lomb's [Istalol \(timolol maleate\)](#) 0.5% ophthalmic solution.
- Istalol is indicated for the treatment of elevated intraocular pressure in patients with ocular hypertension or open-angle glaucoma.
- Ophthalmic timolol maleate is also available generically as 0.25% and 0.5% [gel forming solutions](#) and 0.25% and 0.5% [solutions](#).
 - These forms of timolol maleate carry the same indication as Istalol.
 - Istalol and the gel forming solutions are administered into the affected eye(s) once daily.
 - The solutions are administered into the affected eye(s) twice daily.



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
