

## Kaletra® (Iopinavir/ritonavir) - First-Time Generic

- On January 15, 2017, Lannett launched an <u>AA-rated</u> generic version of AbbVie's <u>Kaletra</u> (<u>lopinavir/ritonavir</u>) oral solution for the treatment of HIV-1 infection in adults and pediatric patients (≥ 14 days old) when used in combination with other antiretroviral agents.
  - The use of other active agents with Kaletra is associated with a greater likelihood of treatment response.
  - Genotypic or phenotypic testing and/or treatment history should guide the use of Kaletra.
    The number of baseline lopinavir resistance-associated substitutions affects the virologic response to Kaletra.
- Kaletra is currently available as a branded tablet formulation which carries the same indication as the oral solution.
