

## Liptruzet<sup>®</sup> (atorvastatin/ezetimibe) – First-time generic

- On January 4, 2023, [Althera launched](#) a [generic version](#) of Merck's discontinued Liptruzet (atorvastatin/ezetimibe) tablets.
  - Merck notified the FDA on June 1, 2015, that Liptruzet tablets were being discontinued. The [FDA determined](#) that Liptruzet tablets were not withdrawn for reasons of safety or effectiveness.
- [Atorvastatin/ezetimibe](#) is approved for primary hyperlipidemia and homozygous familial hypercholesterolemia.
