

## Moxeza® (moxifloxacin) – First-time generic

- On February 14, 2020, <u>Lupin launched</u> an <u>AT-rated</u> generic version of Alcon's <u>Moxeza</u> (<u>moxifloxacin</u>) 0.5% ophthalmic solution.
- Moxeza is approved for the treatment of bacterial conjunctivitis caused by susceptible strains of organisms.
- Moxifloxacin ophthalmic is also available as a generic <u>0.5% ophthalmic solution</u> (Vigamox<sup>®</sup>) approved to treat bacterial conjunctivitis caused by susceptible strains of organisms.
- Moxeza had sales of approximately \$10 million in the U.S. according to IQVIA for the 12 months ending December 2019.
