

Tygacil® (tigecycline) – First-time generic

- On November 30, 2017, Sandoz launched an <u>AP-rated</u> generic version of <u>Tygacil (tigecycline)</u> injection.
- Tygacil is indicated for the treatment of complicated skin and skin structure infections, complicated intra-abdominal infections, and community-acquired bacterial infections caused by susceptible isolates of certain bacteria.
 - Consult Tygacil's drug label for information about susceptible isolates for each indication.
 - Tygacil is not indicated for the treatment of diabetic foot infections.
 - Tygacil is not indicated for the treatment of hospital-acquired or ventilator-associated pneumonia.
- Tygacil carries a boxed warning for all-cause mortality.



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
