

Viagra® (sildenafil) – First-time generic

- Greenstone, a wholly owned subsidiary of Pfizer, will be launching an <u>authorized generic</u> version of <u>Viagra (sildenafil)</u> tablets on Monday, December 11, 2017.
 - Teva Pharmaceuticals received FDA approval of an <u>AB-rated</u> generic version of Viagra on March 9, 2016.
 - Teva could also exclusively launch its generic Viagra on Monday, December 11, 2017.
- Viagra is approved for the treatment of erectile dysfunction.
- Greenstone plans to sell the authorized generic version of Viagra at one-half the \$65 per pill retail
 cost of Viagra. Teva has not disclosed the price for its AB-rated generic.
- Generic <u>Revatio[®] (sildenafil)</u> tablets are also available for the treatment of pulmonary arterial hypertension (WHO Group I) in adults to improve exercise ability and delay clinical worsening.
- The <u>U.S. sales</u> of Viagra were \$1.2 billion in 2016.



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
